

2021年天津中医药大学国际学生 招生简章

天津中医药大学始建于 1958 年,已入围教育部、国家中医药管理局、天津市政府三方共建高校之列,是原国家教委批准的唯一一所中国传统医药国际学院,是世界中医药学会联合会教育指导委员会主任委员单位。为国家教育部"教育援外基地"、外交部和教育部"中国-东盟教育培训中心"、国家中医药管理局"中医药国际合作基地"、世界中联"一带一路"中医药教育师资培训基地(天津)。学校秉承"进德修业,继承创新"的校训,经过多年发展,现已成为中医药教育为主,医学、理学、文学、管理学、工学、教育学等学科门类齐全的综合性大学。2017 年,学校入选国家"双一流"建设高校名单,中药学科入选国家"双一流"建设学科。

学校师资力量雄厚,实习资源充足,专业设置合理,有针灸推拿学和中医内科学 2 个国家级重点学科,现有直属附属医院 3 所,非直属附属医院 4 所。其中,第一附属医院是国家中医临床研究基地、全国针灸临床研究中心、全国针灸临床基地和全国省级示范中医医院;第二附属医院是中医疑难病诊疗中心,妇科、脑病的临床和科研具有显著优势;附属保康医院及其他教学医院在中医康复、中医骨伤、中医社区医疗、中西医临床等方面各具诊疗特色。

学校广泛开展国际交流与合作,注重培养理论知识扎实、临床操作能力强的国际应用型临床人才,在国际上享有较高的声誉,现已发展成为本科教育为主体,涵盖硕士、博士等高层次教育及长短期进修的传统医药国际化人才培养体系。每年约有来自 60 多个国家和地区的 2000 多名国际学生来校学习。

学校新校区座落于天津市静海区团泊湖畔。校园以湖水景观为特点、中药植被为标志、中医药文化为主线,是全国最大的中药植物园、全国最先进的中医药科技园及在国际上具有影响的中医药国际教育中心。

Tianjin University of Traditional Chinese Medicine Admissions for International Students, 2020

Established in 1958, Tianjin University of Traditional Chinese Medicine (TUTCM) has been listed as one of the co-constructed higher educations by Ministry of Education (MOE), State Administration of Traditional Chinese Medicine (SATCM) and Tianjin Municipal Government. It is the only former State Education Commission (Present MOE) approved International University of Traditional Chinese Medicine and also the hosting institution of Educational Instruction Committee, World Federation of Chinese Medicine Societies (WFCMS), "Educational Aid Center" and "China-ASEAN Educational Training Center" of Ministry of Foreign Affairs (MFA) and Ministry of Education, TCM International Cooperation Center of SATCM, and WFCMS "Belt & Road" Training Center for Chinese Medicine Education Teachers. Adhering the motto of "Strengthening moral education and pursuing academic studies, inheriting and innovating", TUTCM has developed into a comprehensive university specializing in TCM education and covers extensive areas of study, namely as Medicine, Science, Arts, Management, Engineering, Education and etc. In 2017, the university was selected into China "Double First-class" university and Chinese Materia Medica was selected into "Double First-rate" programs.

The University has distinguished teaching staff and sufficient resources for students' internship. Currently it has two National Key Programs of Acupuncture & Moxibustion and *Tuina* and TCM Internal Medicine. There are three affiliated and four non-direct affiliated hospitals. Among them, the First Teaching Hospital is a National TCM Clinical Research Center, the National Acupuncture Clinical Research Center, the National Acupuncture Clinical Center and the National Provincial Demonstration TCM Hospital; the Second Teaching Hospital is the treatment center for TCM rare diseases and leading in gynecology and encephalopathy diseases; Baokang Hospital and other teaching hospitals have unique treatment features in TCM Rehabilitation, TCM Orthopedics, TCM Community Health, Clinical Integrative Medicine and etc.

The University has extensive international exchanges and cooperation. It aims to cultivate international applied talents in clinic with solid theoretical foundation and excellent clinical skills which make it enjoy a high reputation worldwide. It has formed TCM internationalization talents training system where the bachelor education is the main part. The system also covers master and doctoral education and short and long term certificate studies. Every year, there are over 2,000 international students from more than 60 countries or regions coming to study at TUTCM.

The new campus of TUTCM is located by Tuanbo Lake in Jinghai District, Tianjin. It is the biggest TCM botanic garden, the most advanced TCM science and technology park and an influential center for TCM international education in china, characterized by an in-campus lake view, TCM vegetation and culture.

How to Apply

For Degree Students

I. Application Requirements

- Non-Chinese Citizens
- Healthy
- HSK4 or above for courses taught in Chinese
- Fluent in English for courses taught in English

A. Bachelor's Degree:

- i. Senior high school graduates, or those with equivalent degree or above;
- **ii.** Profound chemistry background required for Clinical Pharmacy, Clinical Pharmacy (Joint Education), Chinese Materia Medica, Pharmacy, Pharmaceutical Preparation, TCM Resources and Development, TCM Pharmaceutics, and Pharmaceutical Engineering;
- **iii.** Excellent English proficiency required for Chinese and Western Clinical Medicine (English) and Clinical Pharmacy (Joint Education).

Notes: *Overseas Chinese applicant for bachelor's program must be granted for foreign citizenship for at least 4 years, during which the applicant should stay or study in that foreign country for at least 2 years within recent 4 years.

*Applicants under 18 year-old shall proceed with notarization of the guardians in Tianjin.

B. Master's Degree

i. Medical Degree:

Academic Degree: holder of a Bachelor's Degree

a. Clinical Degree (one of the following):

- Holder of a bachelor's degree in TCM;
- Holder of a bachelor's degree in Western Medicine may apply for a master's degree in the category of integrative medicine, for other majors should complete the designated courses in TCM, or have a license in TCM or Acupuncture in their residing country;
- Holder of non-medical undergraduate degree and has completed the designated TCM courses or have a license in TCM or Acupuncture their residing country.
- **b.** Chinese Materia Medica requires a bachelor's degree in Chinese Meteria Medica, Pharmacy, or Medicine.
- c. Nursing requires a bachelor's degree in Nursing only.
- ii. Non-Medical Degree: a bachelor's degree in relevant areas.

C. Academic Doctoral Degree (one of the following):

- Holder of a master's degree in TCM related majors;
- Holder of a master's degree in Western Medicine may apply for a doctoral degree in the category of integrative medicine, for other majors should complete the designated courses in TCM, or have a license in TCM or Acupuncture in their residing country;
- Chinese Materia Medica requires a master's degree in Pharmacy, or related majors.

Notes: *An undergraduate or master's degree in medicine or related majors is required for master's or doctoral program in English respectively.

VII. Admission procedures for foreign applicants:

- **A.** The application documents will be examined by the university online, and the students should pay the application fee upon the approval of their documents (Please attach the applicant's name shown on their passport when transferring, and provide the remittance receipts to the university as well).
- **B.** The university sends Admission Letter and JW202 Form (Visa Application Form for Study in China, for stay in China over 180 days); please check online the application status and information in time.
- C. Apply for an X1 or X2 visa at the Chinese embassy.
- **D.** Report and register in TUTCM immediately after entry into China, verify/re-do physical examination and apply for a residence permit within 30 days.
